MILKY WAY CARPET (US Item # 3504; CN Item # 35r04)

Milky Way Carpet

NOTE: A light source is not included in the Milky Way Carpet. Please order a light source separately. Please refer to the separate instructions for light source. We recommend the use of a heat filter in the light source with carpets if older, non-LED light sources are used.

ASSEMBLY:

1. Place the carpet flat on the floor, away from the doorway.

Note: In order to avoid damage to the fiber optics, hoists, or other heavy weights should not be pushed over the carpet. Heavy use by wheelchairs or feet may also cause damage to the fiber optics. To prevent this, do not place the Milky Way Carpet in a doorway or other area where heavy wear is likely.

2. Slide the boss into the metal tubing on the front face of the light source and secure (see instructions for light source).

Should you wish to wall mount your carpet, first attach the carpet to medium density fiber board using carpet tacks or staples. Attach the board to the wall using screws and wall plugs. Fixtures are not included and should be selected with care. Make sure all fixtures chosen will support the carpet's weight and board. When you use the carpet on the floor, consider the location of your light source. Make sure it is out of your clients' reach.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

1. The tip of the fiber optic produces the most brightness. If the pile becomes flattened light loss will be significant. Regular vacuum cleaning will keep the pile in a good condition.
2. Use a heat filter if your light source has a dichroic lamp rather than LEDs.
3. Store and use the carpet flat. Do not bend or roll it.

NOTE: If the fiber optic is accidentally fractured, light will be emitted from both sides and end, creating an unusual and different effect.

4. If the carpet is soiled, use dry powder cleaners or sponge it with a damp cloth and mild detergent.

DO NOT USE EXCESSIVE AMOUNTS OF WATER.

DO NOT USE STRONG SOLVENTS AS THEY WILL MELT THE FIBER OPTICS.

DO NOT USE SPOT CLEANERS SUCH AS TRICHLOROETHANE 111 OR CHEWING GUM REMOVERS.

DO NOT ALLOW CONTACT WITH TEMPERATURES OF 100° AND OVER.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

NOTE: Fiber optics products are a constant source of safe tactile and visual stimulation but they should always be used under professional supervision. Install the light source out of reach of clients.
