## **INTERACTIVE STAR CARPET (US Item # 37624; CN Item # 376r24)**

### **COMPONENTS:**

- (1) Carpet
- (1) LED Light Source
- (1) Power Adapter
- (1) Power lead (to connect to the unit)
- (1) Computer lead (to connect to the unit to a PC)

### **ASSEMBLY:**

1. Position the carpet on the floor, keeping in mind the following: suggestions/recommendations:
  - Do not place the carpet in a doorway or any area where heavy wear is likely.
  - Position the light source out of clients' reach.
  - Never allow the client to pull on the connection.
  - Keep away from excessive heat sources. A maximum working temperature of 75°C is recommended.
2. Slide the light spray end into the metal tubing on the front face of the light source, aligning the hole on the tubing with the screw in the boss.
3. Tighten the screw.
4. Connect the other lead from the carpet into the 5-pin DIN plug labeled 'REMOTE' at the back of the Light Source.
5. Connect the power lead to the right hand socket. Switch on at the light source.
6. Apply pressure to the mats to activate the fiber optic display. The carpet may be walked on either with shoes or barefoot. **Note: a click may be heard as pressure is applied to the carpet. This is normal—it is the sound of the light source reacting to the pressure switch inside the carpet.**

### **PROGRAMMING YOUR LIGHT SOURCE:**

This light source is compatible with the new Interactive Tablet and Software in the SNOEZELEN® everysense™ range.

1. To do this, connect your unit to your PC using the supplied computer lead (the socket is on the back of the light source, in the middle next to the power socket.)
2. To download the programming software and instructions on how to program your light source, please visit [www.rompa.com](http://www.rompa.com).
3. In the 'QUICKSHOP' box, enter 18517 and click on 'GO'.
4. A picture of the light source will come up—click on 'details' which will take you to another screen.
5. Click 'SAMPLE' to download a zip file containing the software and a copy of this document.
6. Unzip the file and double click RGBEditor.exe.

**\*\*Software is compatible with Windows 95/98/ME/2000 and XP. You will need a 9pin serial port free on your computer.**

## **CARE:**

1. Do not push heavy weights such as hoists over the carpet.
2. Store the carpet flat. Do not bend or roll the carpet.
3. The tip of the fiber optic produces the most brightness and if the pile becomes flattened there will be significant light loss. Regular cleaning with a vacuum cleaner will keep the pile in good condition.
4. If soiling of the carpet occurs dry powder cleaners may be used or the carpet may be sponged with a damp cloth and mild detergent:
  - **DO NOT USE EXCESSIVE AMOUNTS OF WATER.**
  - **DO NOT USE STRONG SOLVENTS AS THEY WILL MELT THE FIBER OPTICS.**
  - **DO NOT USE SPOT CLEANERS SUCH AS TRICHLOROETHANE 111 OR CHEWING GUM REMOVERS.**
  - **DO NOT ALLOW CONTACT WITH TEMPERATURES OF 100° C AND OVER.**

## **MAINTENANCE:**

Since this light source contains LED rather than diachronic lamps, it is highly unlikely that the LED will need changing.
