UV Fiber-Optic Spray (US Item #s 9073; CN Item # 90R73)

PLEASE NOTE: A light source is not included in the UV Fiber Optics. Please order a light source separately. **Please note: You do not need a UV light source—you need a standard or interactive light source and you have the option of using these under a UV lamp.** Please refer to separate instructions for the appropriate light source. Since the UV fiber optics have colored strands, you may wish to remove the color wheel from your light source before using the UV fiber optics. You could leave the color in your light source but it will have a subtle effect only.

These fiber-optic sprays have the added safety feature of crimped ends which seal the fibers inside the plastic sheaths. The fiber optic refurbishment kit is supplied for use in case accidental damage causes the glass fibers to become exposed. Repair damaged fibers immediately.

ASSEMBLY

Attach the light spray to the light source. Please see instructions for light source.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

NOTE: Fiber-Optic products are a constant source of safe tactile and visual stimulation but they should always be used under professional supervision. Please remember the following important points:

1. Though safe to stroke across the face, the strands should never be placed in the mouth. They are made from glass fibers encased in robust PVC tubes. Biting could cause these fibers to get into the mouth.
2. A refurbishment kit is included and should be used should any tails break.
3. We do not recommend the use of fiber optics for play.

USE OF FIBER-OPTIC PRODUCTS

The UV Fiber-Optic Spray has color along its length to the tip where the light is brightest. For added visual appeal the strands may be placed in an ultraviolet environment to give a glow-in-the-dark effect, such as UV Lamp.

ULTRAVIOLET LIGHTS

Overexposure to UV light may cause light problems. Scientific studies have concluded that the maximum safe length of time for exposure to UV light is one hour for adults and five hours for children per day, assuming the UV light is at ceiling height.

Some suggestions for use:

1. Attach a light source to a wall with the spray cascading down like a waterfall.
2. Stroke the strands to demonstrate that it is safe.
3. Fan out the bright tips to cast a colored light across the hand or face.
4. Spread the strands over a mat or seating and lay or sit the user on top.
5. Wrap the spray round limbs or the whole body.
6. Weave the strands in and out of a jumper. Or weave the m in and out of netting which can then be draped over the user or suspended from a wall.
7. Use interactively with a switching system.
